In order to provide supervision, an LCSW or social worker who the Board determines to have the qualifications equivalent of those required of an LCSW must be fully licensed for a minimum of three (3) years The supervisee, PLMSW or LMSW, must be currently employed in a master's level clinical position for the supervision to be applied
