FISCAL MANAGEMENT for NON-GOVERNMENTAL · ...

NGO has reasonable assurance the money will be available, whether from the NGO, donor groups, or other sources (see Figure 1) This is the budget that should be presented to the governing board for formal approval It will also be the basic working tool for the financial management of the organisation during the fiscal year
