2 NUMBNESS: Due to proximity of tooth roots (especially wisdom teeth) and other surgical sites to the nerves, it is possible to loose function of nerves following the removal of the tooth or surgery in the area The lip, chin, teeth, gums, or tongue could thus feel numb (resembling local anesthetic injection)

Oral Surgery - Extractions There are many reasons why a tooth may require extraction Some of these reasons include fracture of the crown or root, receding gums, severe periodontal disease resulting in loss of bone supporting the tooth, infection of the tooth root or bone surrounding the tooth, sometimes overcrowding of teeth
