Health-Related Quality of Life (HRQOL) is a measure of a person's perception of their own physical and mental health The CDC validated a compact set of measures to assess HRQOL, known as the "Healthy Days Measures" They assess a person's sense of well-being based on four measures: 1) self-rated health, 2) number of recent days when

WHO Quality of Life Scale-Brief individually scored items about an individual's overall perception of quality of life and health The four domain scores are scaled in a positive direction with higher scores indicating a higher quality of life Three items of the WHOQOL-Brief must be reversed before scoring
